







Defensive and Competitive Bidding
<b>Overcalls (Style; Responses; Reopening)</b>
Light 1 level, sound 2 level New suit from unpassed advancer is F1, Cue = support After 1M, 2NT in COMP is 4+ SUPP, jumps short w/SUPP (1x) - 1M - (DBL) TRF from 1NT
<b>1 NT overcall (2ND/4TH; Responses; Reopening)</b>
(14)15-17(18), same responses as to 1NT opening
<b>Jump Overcalls (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)</b>
Preemptive, aggressive style especially green 2NT at least 5-5 in minors
<b>Direct and Jump Cue Bids (Style; Responses)</b>
(1m) - 2m = 5-5 in majors; (1M) - 2M = 5-5 in OM + ♣ Jump cue asks for stopper
<b>VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopen: PH)</b>
<b>Vs. strong:</b> Dbl = equal strength, 2♣ = ♥+♠, 2♦ = 5+ ♥ or ♠, 2♥ = 4(5)♥ + 5+minor, 2♠ = 4(5)♠ + 5+minor, 2NT = both minors or strong 2-suiter
<b>VS weak:</b> Dbl = (13)14+, 2♣ = ♥+♠, 2♦ = 5+ ♥ or ♠ 13+, 2♥ = (5)6+ ♥ 8-12, 2♠ = (5)6+ ♠ 8-12
In 4 <sup>th</sup> hand and by PH: DBL = both m or one M; 2m = the suit and one M, 2M = NAT
<b>VS. Preempts (Doubles; Cue bids; Jumps; NT bids)</b>
Takeout double, 2NT = ca. 15-18 Cue to 3 level asks stopper, to 4 level two-suiter Leaping and non-leaping Michaels (Multi 2♦) - 4m = the suit + one major
<b>VS. Artificial Strong Openings</b>
Vs. strong 1♣: and 1♦ NEG resp: DBL = ♥+♠, 1NT = ♣+♦.
<b>Over Opponents' take out double</b>
XX = 10+ HCP, penalty interest 1M - (DBL) - transfers from 1NT
